




















What to do if you **FAIL** the COVID-19 screening

Fully vaccinated: it has been 14 days or longer since your second dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

Scenario 1	Action
<p>You or a family member has any one of these symptoms:</p> <div style="display: flex; flex-wrap: wrap; justify-content: space-around;"> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  fever <small>37.8 °C or 100 °F or higher</small> </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  cough </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  hard to breathe </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  sore throat </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  decrease/loss taste or smell </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  stuffy/runny nose </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  nausea vomiting diarrhea </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  headache </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  muscle aches </div> <div style="text-align: center; margin: 5px;">  very tired </div> </div>	<div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Person with symptoms must stay home and get tested, even if they've received the COVID-19 vaccine. All household members must stay home, unless they are fully vaccinated. <p style="text-align: center; color: red; font-weight: bold; font-size: 1.2em;">BOOK a COVID-19 TEST at a Testing Centre</p> <p>Visit www.hpph.ca/COVID19Test for COVID testing information.</p>
<p>If COVID-19 test is POSITIVE</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Public health will contact you and let you know what to do.
<p>If COVID-19 test is NEGATIVE.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Symptomatic person can go back to school/work once they have been feeling better for 24 hours. Any household contacts who have been isolating can go back to work or school as long as they have no symptoms.
<p>If symptomatic person was not tested.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Symptomatic person MUST stay home and isolate. Symptomatic person MUST self-isolate away from others in the home. Symptomatic person can return to work/school after 10 days, if they are fever-free (without medicine), and their symptom(s) has been resolved or improving for 24 hours. <p>Note: Vaccine status of the symptomatic person does not change what they do in this scenario.</p> <p>Household members:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Household members must stay home and self-isolate for 10 days, unless they are fully vaccinated. If a household member develops symptoms they need to isolate and get tested.

Scenario 2	Action
<p>You have received a COVID-19 vaccination in the last 48 hours and have any of these symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • mild headache • fatigue • muscle ache 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If headache, fatigue, or muscle aches began within the 48 hours from the time you received your immunization, and you do not have any other symptoms, and the symptoms are mild, you can attend work/school/ permitted activities. • Workplace policies may go above and beyond this guidance; check with your workplace. • If the symptoms worsen, continue past 48 hours, or if you develop other symptoms, you should self-isolate and seek COVID-19 testing.
Scenario 3	Action
<p>You or someone in your household is a close contact of a COVID-19 case (confirmed by public health)</p> 	<p> If you are NOT fully vaccinated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You MUST self-isolate. Any household members who are not fully vaccinated must also self-isolate. • Public health will follow up about self isolation, testing, and when you can return to work and other activities. • Household members who are fully vaccinated and have no symptoms do not have to self-isolate. <p>If you ARE fully vaccinated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You do not have to self-isolate or stay home as long as you don't have symptoms of COVID-19. • Public health will follow up about isolation and testing. • Your household members do not have to isolate, unless directed by public health. • Monitor for symptoms. • You must report your exposure to your workplace. Note that some workplace policies may go above and beyond this guidance.
Scenario 4	Action
<p>Anyone in the household has travelled outside of Canada</p> 	<p> There are some exemptions to quarantine and testing requirements for those who are fully vaccinated. Please see Canada's guidance for travelers: www.travel.gc.ca/travel-covid</p>
