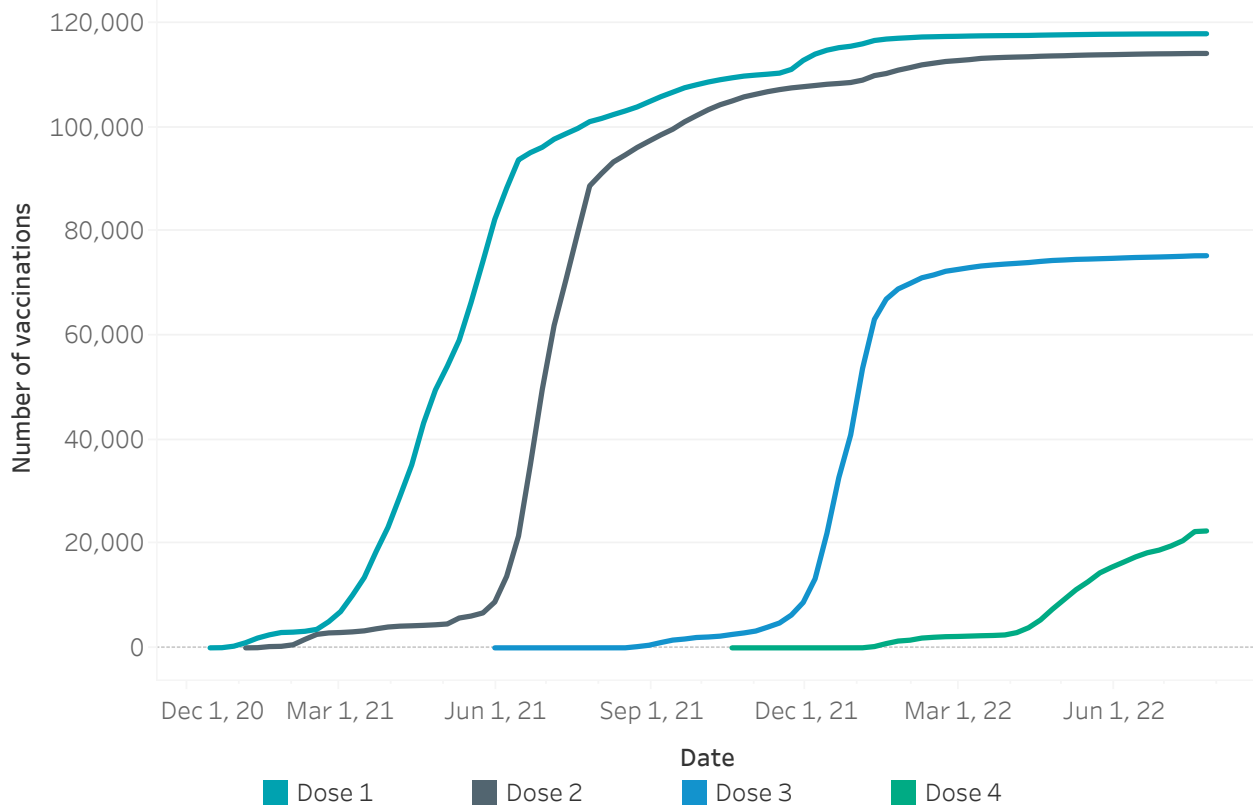

Previously, coverage was calculated based on the age at vaccination. This means that if you received your first dose when you were 69, you would be counted in the 60-69 year age group for your first dose regardless of how old you are now. Coverage is now calculated based on how old you are when the data gets extracted from the provincial system. This means that if you received your first dose when you were 69 but you are now 70, your first dose is now counted in the 70-79 year age group. The coverage percentages by age group and dose now show coverage for Huron-Perth residents based on current age.

This change in how coverage is calculated means that the age group coverages will change every time the dashboard is updated. Every week, there will be Huron-Perth residents who move up an age group.

The total vaccinated by dose and age group in the figure below will be less than the total vaccinated by dose in the figure above because of differences in methodology.
