Purpose

Interactive animal exhibits are enjoyed by people of all ages and are an excellent way to connect with nature. However, interacting with animals can make people sick if precautions are not taken. To prepare for the event, you are required to:

Inform Huron Perth Public Health of any changes to your original application.

Post HPPH-provided signs at all entrances and exits to and from all animal areas that remind visitors to wash their hands.

Have handwashing stations with soap, water and paper towels at all entrances and exits for all animal areas.

Ensure all animals requiring rabies vaccine under *Ontario Regulation 567/90: (O. Reg.) Rabies Immunization* are up to date.

Develop a plan for the prompt removal of manure and soiled bedding to keep the animal enclosures clean. This will help reduce the risk of potential pathogens that could make attendees ill.

Under O. Reg 567/90: Rabies Immunization, rabies vaccination is required Requirements

- 1. Every owner or person having the care or custody of a cat, dog or ferret three months of age or over shall ensure that the cat, dog or ferret is immunized against rabies. O. Reg. 497/17, s. 1.
- 2. (1) Every owner or person having the care or custody of a horse, cow, bull, steer, calf or sheep shall ensure that each such animal is immunized against rabies.

 O. Reg. 497/17, s. 1; O. Reg. 510/18, s. 1 (1).
